

Covid-19 Policy 2021(Revised August 2021)



Policy Statement: We take our responsibilities to minimise the risk of spreading infection very seriously. As such we have decided to continue to work within previous Government guidelines (namely the guidance given as of the 17th May 2021) for our 2021 events. It has been recognised by us and acknowledged by the Government that the risk of transmission in outdoor spaces is lower and when coupled with appropriate hygiene measures will be even lower.

Procedure:

Prior to Arrival

- No-one should attend a session if they or someone they know and have contact with are showing symptoms of COVID-19, or they have been contacted by the NHS Track and Trace System as a 'close contact' and asked to isolate. If this is the case, they should not travel to the site.
- Our booking system will ask for up-to-date contact details and any medical information that would be required should someone fall ill or show symptoms.
- Group Members (or parents/carers of children who are too young to declare) MUST declare the following;
 - Any current COVID 19 symptoms
 - Any NHS Track and Trace contact within the last 14 days
 - Any Isolation periods undergone by their child or a 'close contact' in the last 14 days
- If your child has had to self isolate in the past 14 days you must show evidence of a negative COVID 19 test 24 hours before arrival. This must be in written or photographic form and sent to info@primarysportsgiants.co.uk. Failure to do so may result in your child being refused entry to the event.

On Site

- The risks regarding COVID-19 will be discussed in initial Health and Safety Briefings and we will maintain open conversation with Group Members.
- We ensure good respiratory hygiene by promoting the Government's 'Catch it. Bin it. Kill it' message
- The Primary Sports Giants Team will model good hygiene and Group Members will be encouraged to wash their hands more often than usual, particularly when changing activities and before/after using the toilet.

Covid-19 Policy 2021(Revised August 2021)

- Group Members will be advised to maintain social distancing as much as possible and activities will be modified as far as possible to promote this. Where this is not possible, appropriate PPE will be used such as masks and hand sanitiser. Group Members will be advised that alcohol hand gels are flammable and as such extra caution should be taken before managing fires.
- We will be adhering to previous government guidelines by minimising contact with others by creating 'bubbles' on site.
- We have taken measures to have a designated site away from other groups.
- Group Members will be advised of any 'out of bounds' areas to avoid any 'cross bubble' contamination.
- Any catering companies that are brought in from outside the bubble will keep to the 2 metre rule and will wear appropriate PPE
- Frequently touched surfaces will be cleaned more regularly than usual using standard bleach products. All equipment will be given a final 'end-of-day' clean using sanitiser spray before being securely stored away.
- Any equipment used by Group Members will be thoroughly sanitised before being shared with other bubbles

Overnight Stays (Residential)

- Group members will be provided with Teepee accommodation with appropriate numbers sleeping in each
- Staff will be given the option of individual teepees or shared (2 maximum per teepee)
- Group Members will only share with members of their bubble
- Guidance of extra ventilation in teepees will be given and repeated

If someone becomes unwell on-site

- If anyone becomes unwell with a new continuous cough, or has a high temperature, or has a loss of, or change in their normal sense of smell, they must be sent home and advised to follow COVID-19 guidance for households with Possible COVID-19 infection guidance (available at www.gov.uk/coronavirus)
- A person showing symptoms will be isolated and supervised until their collection arrives. The supervising school staff member should wear appropriate PPE and the area cleaned after the Group Member has been collected.
